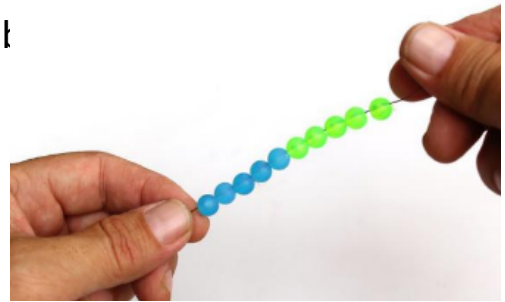
### HOMEWORK

- ❖ Make "A Homemade Abacus" with the help of materials and procedures given below.

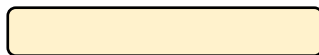
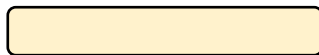
What we use : Popsicle sticks (Ice-cream sticks), thread, beads and glue.

Procedure to do :

Step 1 - Take a thread of your desired length (don't take too long) and then thread few beads of your desired number in each thread. Now, knot the thread tightly so that beads cannot fall out. (As shown in the picture below)



Step 2 - Take two Popsicle sticks and place them in front of it as shown.



Step 3 - Now paste the threaded beads on both the popsicle sticks as shown below. Your homemade abacus is ready.
