Students are required to prepare the projects with relevant material carefully pertaining to each subject. The submission of the project will be by 31st of August, 2021 without fail.

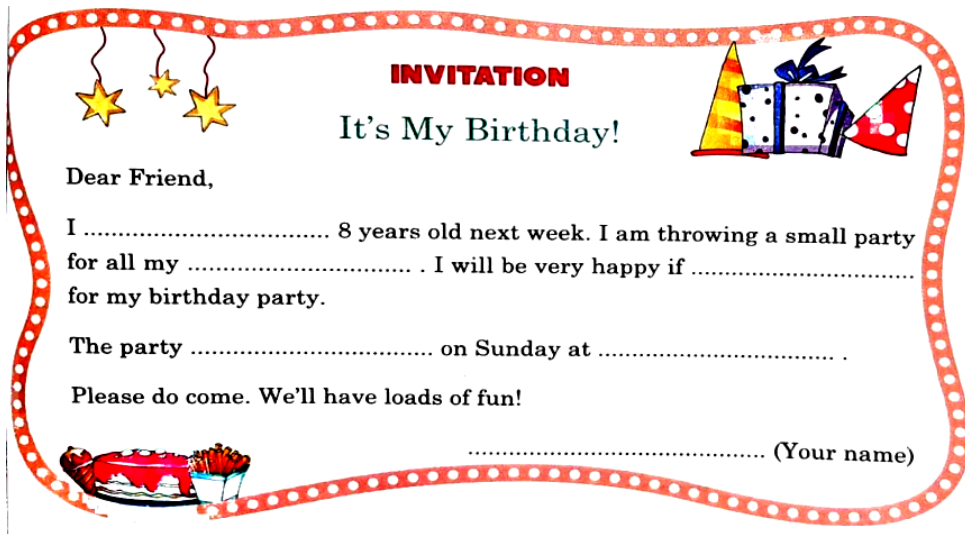

### HOMEWORK

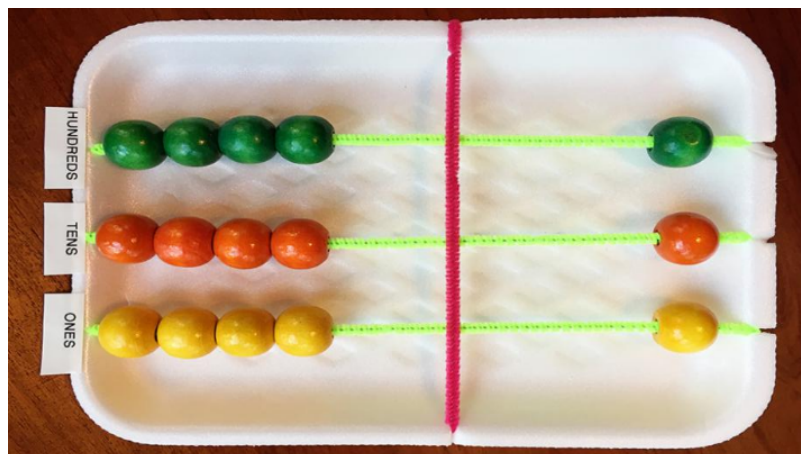
- ❖ Write Roman numerals from 1 to 20 with matchstick on a sheet of chart paper.

(Take the help from the picture given below)

Materials Used : A cardboard box or a shoe box of medium size, some beads, thread, tape, glue, pencil and scissors.

How to make :

Step1 - Thread 5 beads onto each thread. Each thread will represent a column of the place value chart (ones, tens, hundreds and thousands) so you will need four threads. One bead will rest at the top, the other four at the bottom.

Step2 - Now keep the box vertically and stick the threads tightly on both the ends of the cardboard with tape properly. Stick the name slips of the place values on the respective threads.
