Attention:

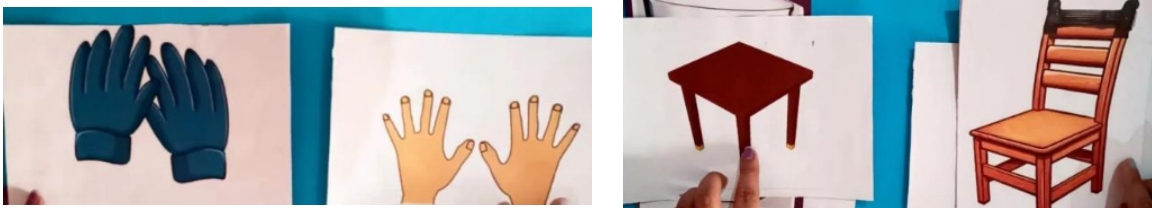
Students are required to prepare the projects with relevant material carefully pertaining to each subject. The submission of the project will be by 31st of August, 2021 without fail.
